## RE: TAX EXEMPT STATUS OF CONCORD MONTHLY MEETING

To whom it may concern:

Concord Monthly Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends is recognized by the IRS as exempt from federal income tax under IRC Section 501(c)(3), since it is included in the group exemption ruling of New England Yearly Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers).

New England Yearly Meeting (NEYM) is a 501(c)(3) tax exempt, religious non-profit organization and association of churches; our Internal Revenue Service determination letter is dated 1943. A 2006 IRS letter affirms our 501(c)(3) status and affirms that NEYM is classified as a church. Our IRS Group Exemption ruling letter is dated 8/18/2020. IRS Publication 4573 explains, "A group exemption letter has the same effect as an individual exemption letter except that it applies to more than one organization. ... Donors may rely on central organization verification about deductibility of contributions to subordinates covered in a Section 501(c)(3)group exemption ruling."
